- Chipboard (i.e. cereal boxes, cookie/cracker boxes, gift boxes, detergent boxes)
- Glass (clear, green and brown food and beverage containers only)
- Aluminum and Metal Cans (includes aluminum trays, empty aerosol cans & metal cookware)
- Plastic (all plastic containers and bottles with 1 and 2 on them)
- Newspaper and Magazines
- Corrugated Cardboard
